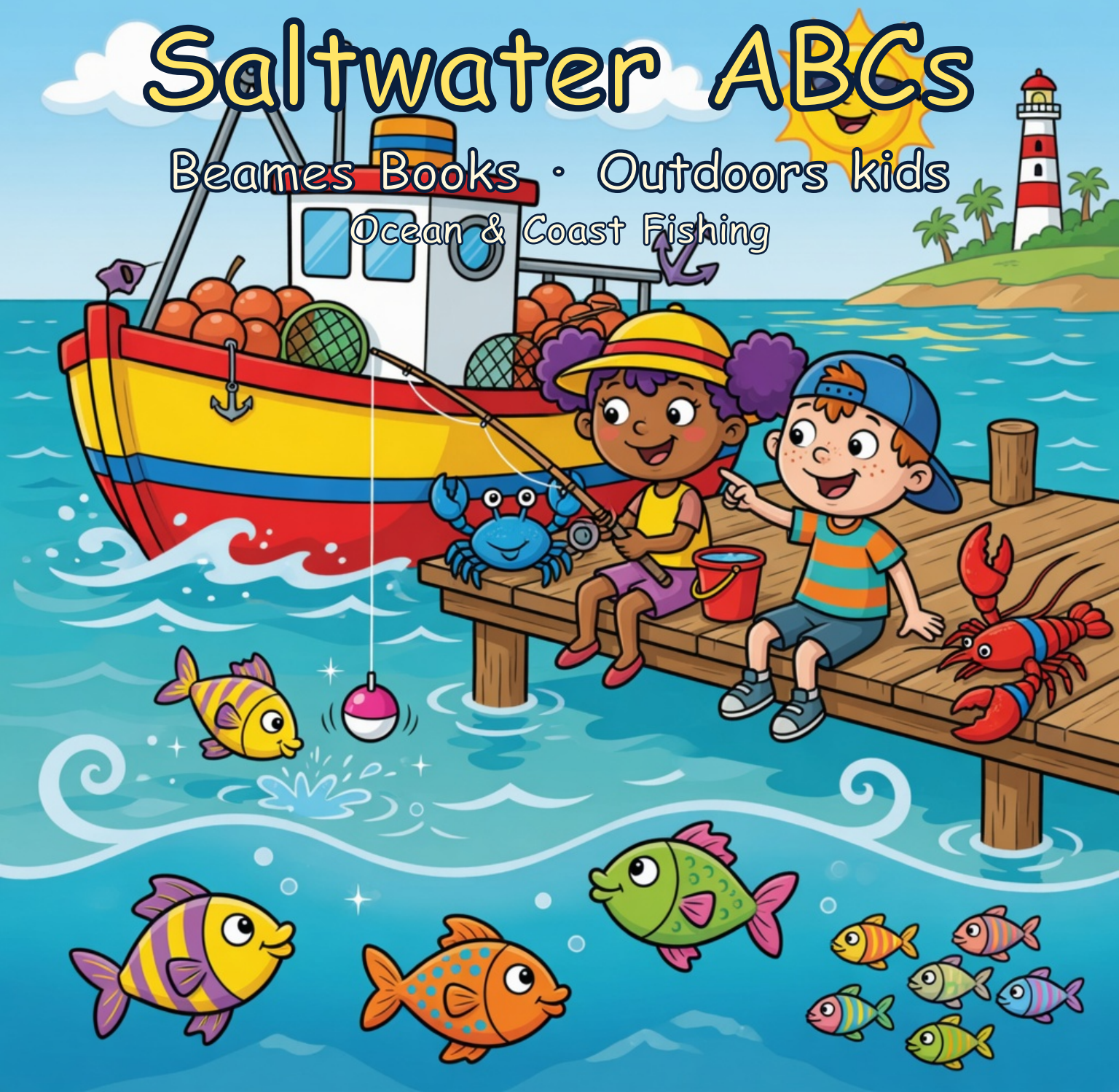

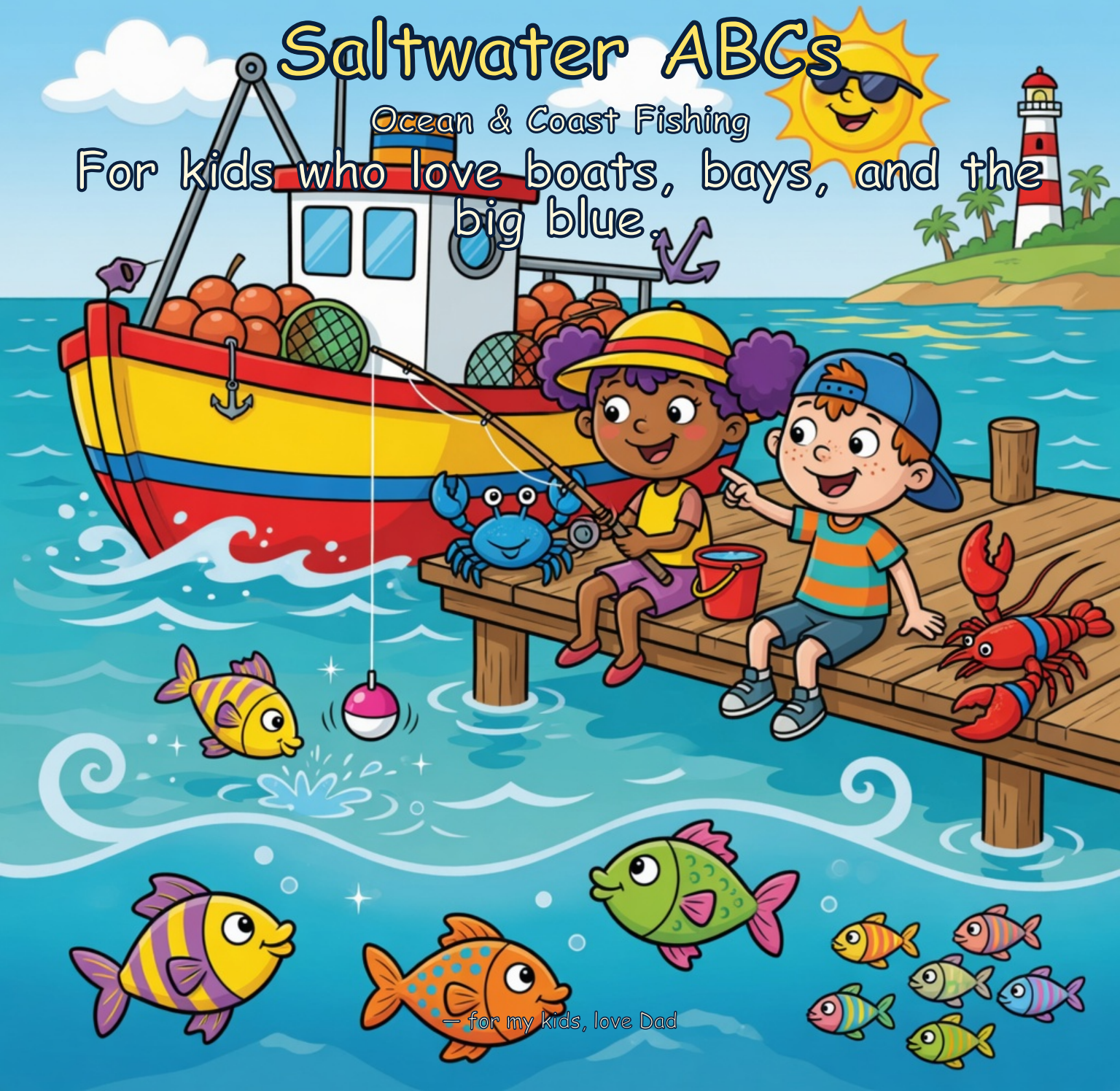

Saltwater ABCs

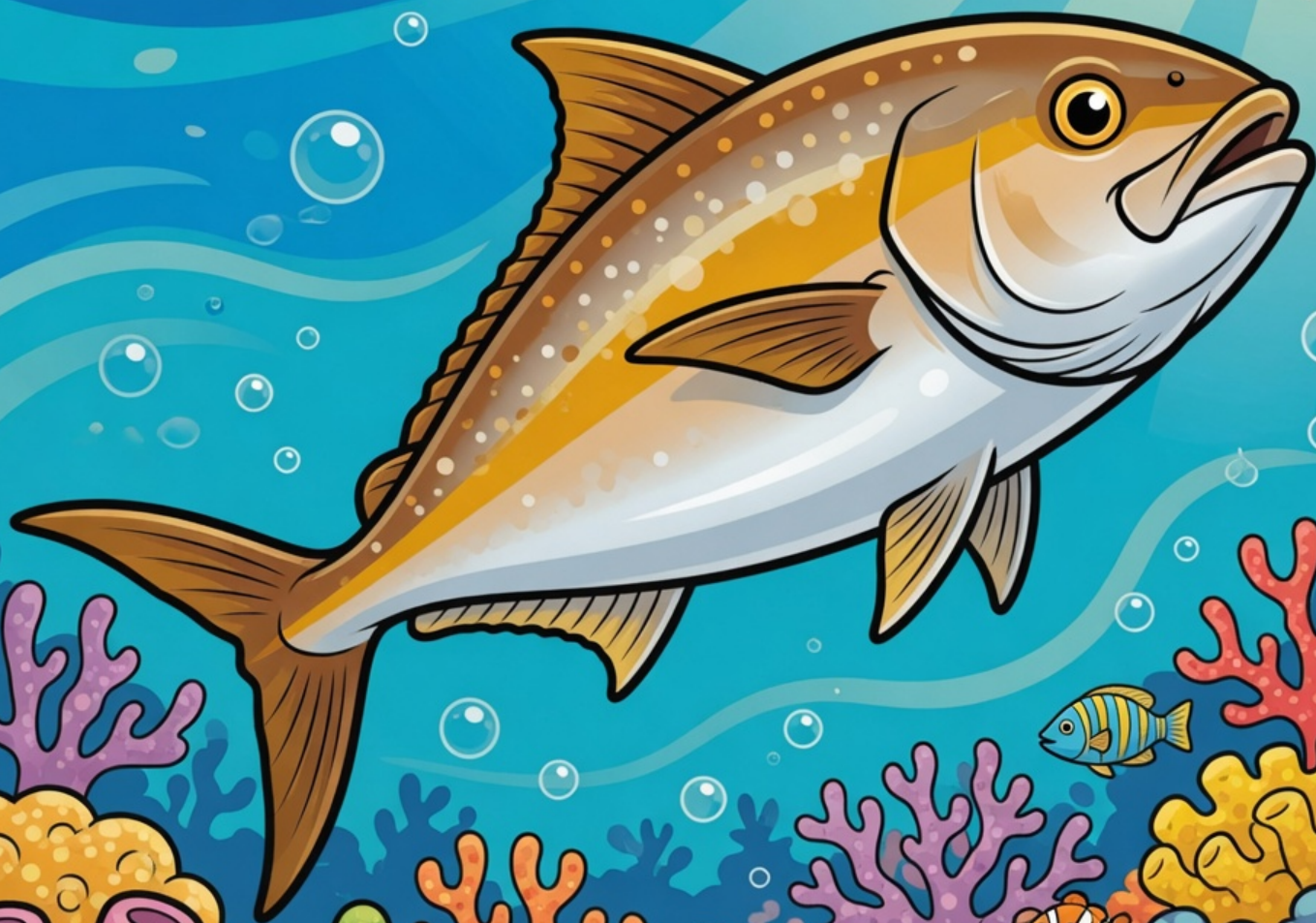
Ocean & Coast Fishing

A is for Amberjack

A is for Amberjack — strong saltwater fighting fish.

B is for Bluefish

C is for Crab — sideways walkers in the tide.



D is for Dogfish

D is for Dogfish — small coastal sharks with a funny name.

E is for Eel

E is for Eel — long slippery fish near rocks and grass.



F is for Flounder

F is for Flounder — flat fish that hide on the bottom.

G is for Grouper

G is for Grouper — big reef fish of warm salt water.

H is for Herring

H is for Herring — silver schools along the coast.

I is for Inshore

I is for Inshore — fishing close to beaches and bays.

J is for Jack crevalle

J is for Jack crevalle — tough jacks of tropical shores.

K is for King mackerel

K is for King mackerel — fast silver speedsters.

L is for Lobster — clawed crustaceans of cold rocks.

M is for Mahi-mahi

M is for Mahi-mahi — bright open-ocean fish (also called dorado).

N is for Needlefish

N is for Needlefish — long thin fish near the surface

O is for Oyster — shellfish that filter the bay.

P is for Pompano

P is for Pompano — tasty fish of sandy beaches.

Q is for Queen snapper

Q is for Queen snapper — deep bright reef fish.

R



R is for Redfish

R is for Redfish — copper-colored hunters of grass flats.



S is for Snapper

S is for Snapper — popular reef and wreck fish.

T is for Tuna

T is for Tuna — powerful swimmers of the deep blue.

U is for Urchin

U is for Urchin — spiny creatures of tide pools.

V is for Vessel

V is for Vessel — the boat that takes you to sea.

W is for Wahoo

W is for Wahoo — striped speedsters offshore.



X is for Xiphias

X is for Xiphias — swordfish family of the open ocean.
