I is for Ice fishing – holes cut through winter ice.

J is for Jig — a lure you bounce near the bottom.

K is for Kayak — a quiet boat for rivers and lakes.

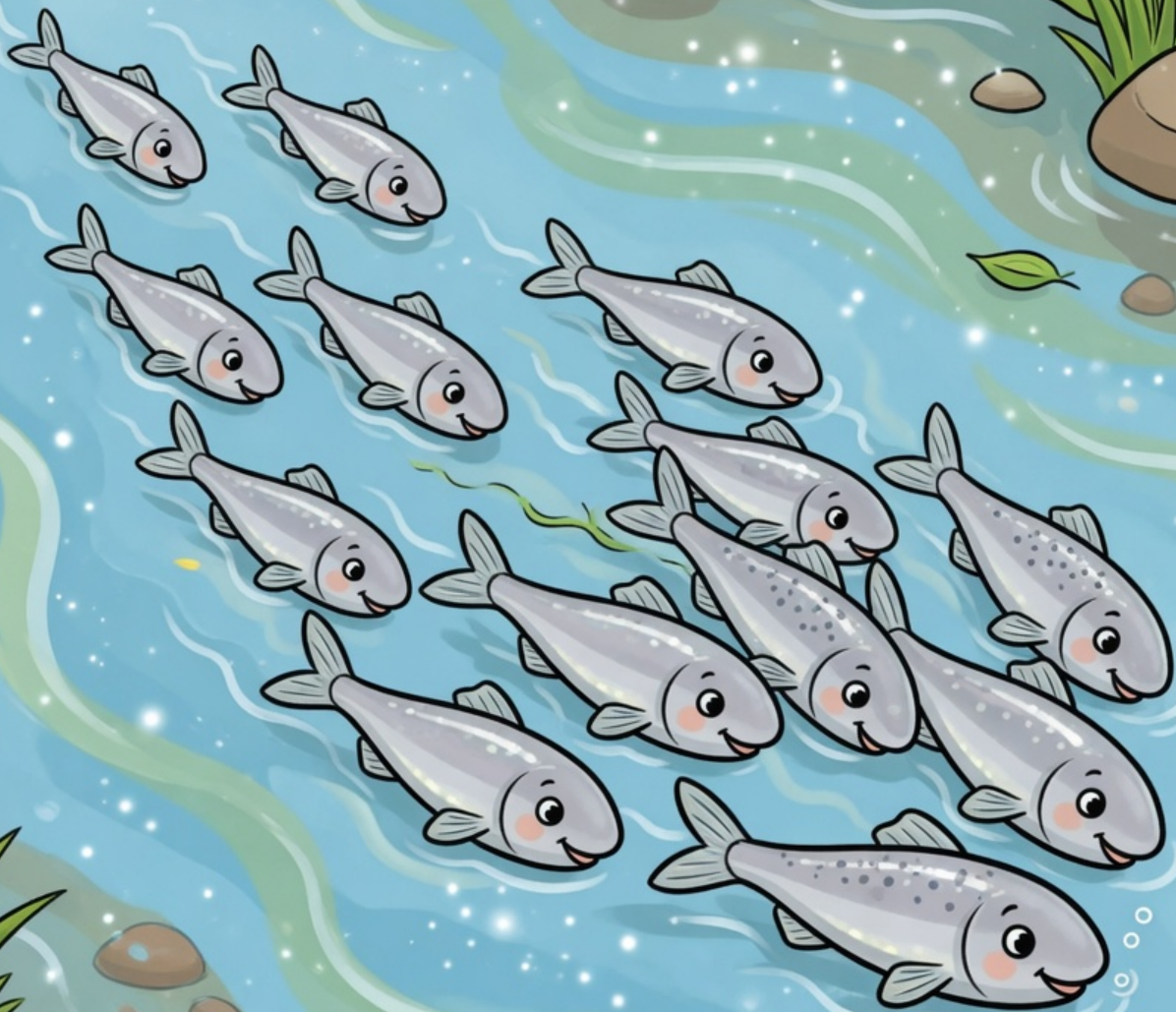


L is for Largemouth

P is for Panfish — bluegill and friends sized for a pan.

Q is for Quiet water — still ponds full of life.

R is for Reel — the spinning part that holds line.

S is for Sunfish

S is for Sunfish — colorful panfish of warm lakes.



T is for Trout

T is for Trout — spotted fish of cool clean streams.



U is for Upstream

U is for Upstream — the direction toward the source.

V is for Vortex — swirling water behind rocks.

W is for Walleye

W is for Walleye — night-feeding fish with big eyes.

X is for X-rig

X is for X-rig — a tackle setup for careful presentations.



Y is for Yellow perch

Y is for Yellow perch — striped panfish of cool lakes.

Z is for Zebra mussel — invasive shells to report, not spread.
